The first meeting of the Nominations & Membership Committee was held at the Law Offices of Heather Mobley in Concord. Heather chairs the Committee and opened the meeting at 8:07 a.m. Members were welcomed and thanked for their attendance. Daniel Sevigny's message explaining his absence and providing his cell number if questions arise was conveyed.

DISCUSSION

To begin, the Committee identified the Council's current and upcoming vacant seats.

- Two Youth under Age 21, or one Youth under Age 21 and a Member of the Public Representing the Interests of Families of At-Risk Juveniles
- Active Living and Parks Department Representative
- Two At-Large Seats
- Local Sheriff or Sheriff's Designee.

A discussion followed regarding the reasons vacancies occurred. During last fiscal year, two members resigned during active terms and three members elected not to renew terms set to expire September 30, 2022. The Committee then reviewed the active applications. (Submitted Applications for Appointments are retained for a period of two years.)

The Committee next discussed qualifications of individual applicants and their potential compatibility with the vacant seats and the duties associated with Council membership.

RECOMMENDATIONS

It was agreed that the recommended candidates will be contacted so the rigors and requirements of Council membership can be explained. It was further agreed interested candidates will be invited to attend the August meeting with a follow-up invitation to the September meeting where Council can ask them questions and vote to recommend appointment.
